

GCYSA Park Transfer Policy and Procedures

Parents are highly encouraged to start the transfer process early in the year and not wait until July

If a parent is requesting a 2nd or more transfer for the same student athlete It is the parents responsibility to attach any information and documentation to the transfer form for consideration

Parents, if you are wishing to transfer your child from one GCYSA member park to another, please read this page entirely.

Parents should not seek out coaches from other parks about transferring their child to his/her team/park. This can put the coach and park in jeopardy of recruiting violations. Gulf Coast Youth Sports Alliance Rules state that a student athlete:

*Must transfer from his/her previous GCYSA park prior to the first day of GCYSA authorized practice and have secured a GCYSA Park Transfer Form signed by the previous Park President, his/her authorized designee or be approved by the GCYSA Appellate Board. Said transfer must be on file with the Alliance office.

*A student-athlete may transfer from a NON-GCYSA park anytime up to the last certification day.

*If a student-athlete transfers to a team that is or will be coached by a coach that was his/her coach from the previous park, the previous season, it will be assumed that the student-athlete has been recruited and will be ineligible for that season unless said coach/coaches step down.

*A student-athlete may only transfer within GCYSA parks 1 time during his/her lifetime. The GCYSA Appellate Board must approve waivers for special circumstances.

*Only 3 student-athletes are allowed to transfer from any neighboring GCYSA park-team and another GCYSA park-team. This will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

*Parks that have accepted 3 student-athlete transfers from any other 1 specific team may accept more from that team IF that team is full, referring student-athletes away or are putting children on a waiting list for that team.

In addition GCYSA Football Rules State in regards to coaches:

*If transferring from another GCYSA park, a coach cannot coach, train or be an attendant if there are any student-athletes from his/her previous team, the previous year, other than his/her own legally documented children, or ones that he/she has documented legal custody of.

*If a student-athlete is allowed to transfer to the team after said coach has transferred it will be automatically assumed the student-athlete has been recruited and either the Coach must step down or the student-athlete not be allowed to play on that team.

Parents wishing to transfer their child from one GCYSA to another should follow these guidelines to seek a Park transfer.

1. Complete a GCYSA Park Transfer Form (See GCYSA Forms link on this Website)
2. Take the form to the departing Park President for his or her release.

NOTE: Students/Parents that owe monies or equipment will not be allowed to transfer until debts are paid. Parents should keep receipts of registration fees and/or equipment sign out receipts as proof they have paid and/or turned equipment in.

3. Transfer form **MUST BE RECEIVED** to the GCYSA office no later than 10 days week prior to the 1st day of practice.

NOTE: If a parent is unable to obtain a release from a park, they MUST NOTIFY the GCYSA Commissioner in writing that they are having trouble or that the transfer is being disputed no later than 10 days prior to the 1st day of practice. The Commissioner will attempt to expedite or mediate the problem so that a resolution can be made before practice begins. After that deadline however, all GCYSA resources are focused on player certifications. Please be advised that the Commissioner may not respond promptly after the deadline because of this.

4. The transfer form will be reviewed to ensure the child meets all of the eligibility requirements and the departing park President will be notified of the approval or denial.
